

A Framework for use of Project Metrics

The Challenge

Many project teams and most Project Management Offices make use of project metrics to measure project health and progress, but metrics can and should do much more. For example, objective metrics are indispensable for determining the true Business Value of a project after its completion. However, with hundreds of metrics to choose from, how does one know which ones to use? Is it sufficient to simply use the "standard" ones? Which metrics are actually "standard"?
